Mission and Scope

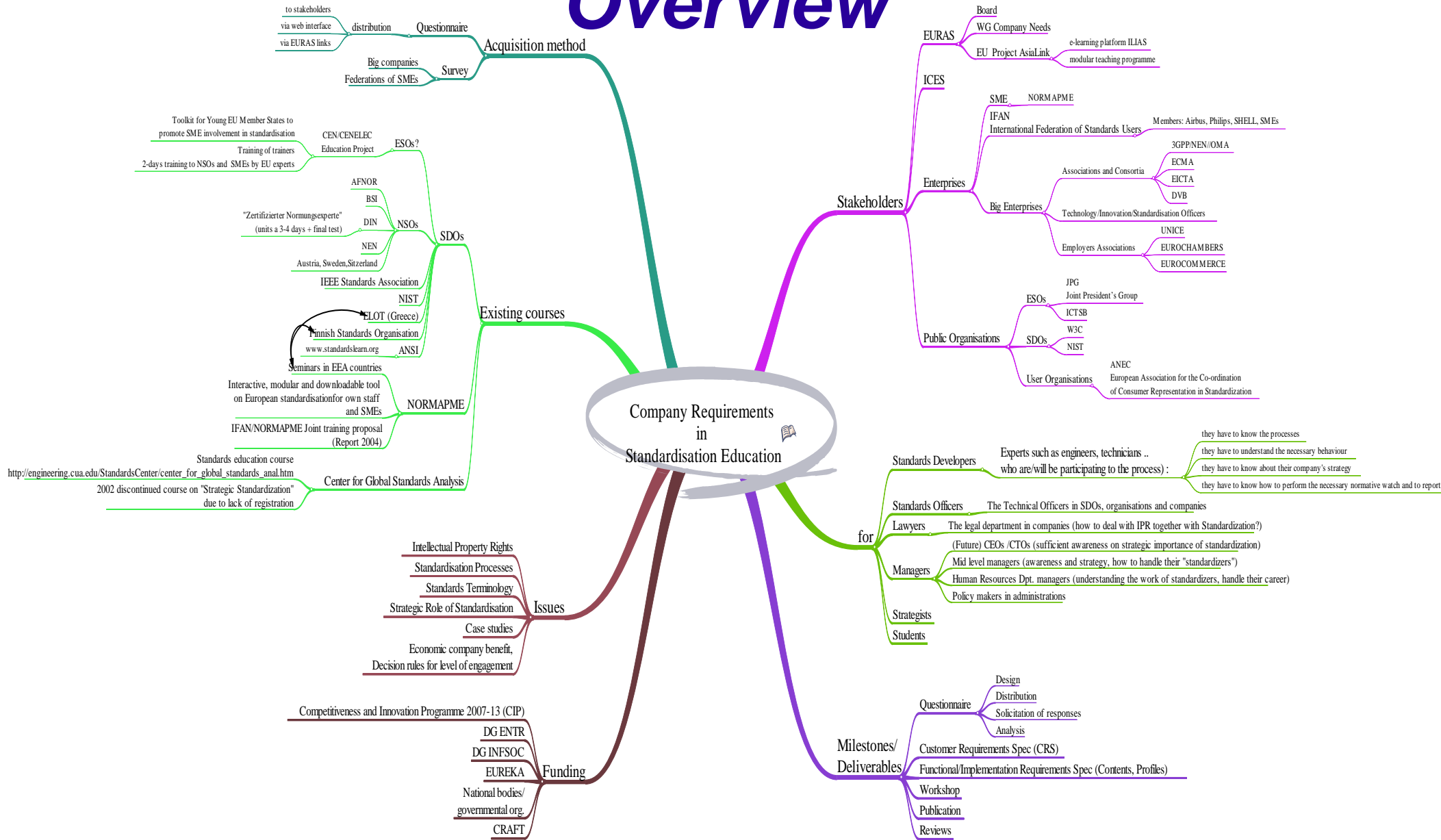
- Point of departure
 - Strategic and technical excellence in standardisation became a fundamental issue for company success in emerging markets. Hence education on standardisation has to take into account the present situation and experiences made in companies and consortia in order to determine the required intellectual assets for standardisation actors and stakeholders.
 - *It is the responsibility of the group to provide the corresponding input for curricula of education programs on standardisation.*
- Mission
 - The group shall identify industry requirements for training and education on standardisation based on the experience and/or perceived lack of knowledge within companies.
 - The group will provide input to education curricula related to standardisation and issue recommendations.

Mission and Scope

- Scope

- The group shall define a methodology (e.g. survey, case studies) to identify the issues to be integrated in an education program on standardisation
- The group will identify the partners to work with (ESOs, ICES, IFAN, NORMAPME...)
- The group shall identify functional categories of employees within the companies who should be knowledgeable in terms of standardisation and determine for each category their specific needs (i.e. for strategists, managers, lawyers ...)
- The group will prepare a report and present it to EURAS
