

How to Get to the EURAS Conference Venue

The EURAS 2025 Conference will be held at **Av. Complutense, 30, Moncloa-Aravaca, 28040 Madrid, Spain**. The venue is the Escuela Técnica Superior de Ingenieros de Telecomunicación (ETSIT), part of the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid (UPM) in Madrid (how to get: <http://www.etsit.upm.es/de/school/about-etsit/how-to-get-to-etsit.html>)

The easiest way to reach ETSIT-UPM/city center from the [airport](#) is to take a taxi outside the arrivals area of the terminal (fixed cost 30 EUR).

You can also reach the city center by underground (<https://www.metromadrid.es/en/travel-in-the-metro/fares-and-tickets/airport>). The station is located in the airport, and you will need to purchase a ticket using one of the machines that are before the gates. Make sure to purchase the ticket with the airport fare. This will amount to approximately 5 EUR in total.

From the city center, you may arrive at ETSIT-UPM by Metro (underground). The closest Metro station to ETSIT-UPM is "**Ciudad Universitaria**", which is located on [Line 6](#). From the Metro station, you have to walk (around 900 meters) or take a bus (lines 82, G, or U - with the stop located right outside of the Metro exit) to ETSIT-UPM premises. Find below the ETSIT-UPM area [Metro](#) map.



Please note that to use the Metro, you will need to purchase the ticket beforehand. Machines will be available at all the stations, and payment is possible by cash or card. 10 trip tickets are the most affordable option. Tickets for the bus can be purchased on the bus itself, with payment by cash and card available. The metro card also works with buses.

Accommodation options

UPM has not got any agreement/discount with hotels in the area, but there are plenty of options available in Madrid. Our recommendation would be to look for a reasonable metro connection to Line 6. For example, Cuatro Caminos or Arguelles Metro stations are not far off. The best one is probably the Glorieta de Cuatro Caminos area: Beyond the multiple metro lines, there is a direct bus that gets you to ETSIT-UPM (Bus F). Other issues

Almost all payments in Madrid can be made by card. Although places only taking cash are not unheard of, they are definitely rare. In the worst-case scenario, ATMs are commonplace. Contactless is also widely available.

The best way to move around the city is by using public transport. Public transport passes can be purchased in any Metro station and are also used to ride buses. There are multiple options, ranging from 10 trips to unlimited ones.
